| <p>Programme Delivery and Development To understand how Leaders and others involved in programme delivery can support adults and participants with the completion of DofE programmes.</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Understand DofE programmes in detail, the role of adults in helping participants and how to put programme delivery into action. • Understand the approval process for Awards. • Be familiar with, and know where to access, resources to assist young people through their DofE programmes. • Be able to explain the benefits to young people of each section of their DofE programme. • Appreciate the importance of young people taking ownership of their DofE programme. • List the possible barriers and some solutions to completions. • Explain the opportunities for young people to be able to progress to the next level. • Encourage DofE Award holders to continue their involvement with the DofE or their DofE activities. • Support young people in maximising the benefits gained from involvement with the DofE. • Identify and use relevant DofE and community resources and other local networks. |
