## Loch an Eilein Campground – Terms & Conditions

*Welcome to Loch an Eilein Campground – We hope you enjoy your stay*

Please observe the following terms and conditions during your stay to ensure this facility continues to be enjoyed by yourself & others.

### Portable Toilet Hire

Due to the increasing popularity of Loch an Eilein as a place to visit and indeed the increased use of the Youth / School camping area, the toilet block situated at Loch an Eilein cannot cope with the increased usage. The camping area is still free of charge but we require groups to hire a portaloos when using the camping area:

1 portaloos for groups between: 15-25

2 portaloos for groups between: 25-40

**Use of Campground** - The campground is designated for youth groups camping. Only tents are permitted, no caravans or camper vans.

**Group Size** - The maximum number of people permitted to camp on the campground at one time is 40.

**Car Parking** - Vehicles must not be driven onto the campground at any time. Please park them in the parking area provided.

**Water** - May be obtained from the outside tap at the toilet block, which is 150m past the car park on the right hand side.

**Toilets** - Loch an Eilein toilets will be left open during your stay on the campground (you must however bring your own supply of toilet tissue, soap etc. for your group). We ask that portaloos are hired in depending on your group numbers (above) to alleviate the pressure on our toilet block.

The toilet block will be closed for cleaning every morning at 9am. Please ensure everyone in your group is aware of this to allow the Ranger staff to get the toilets cleaned for all visitors to the area.

**Washing and Washing-up Area** - Each group using the campground is responsible for setting up a camp utensil wash area on the campground. The washing up of pots, pans and dishes is not permitted in the toilet block or burn next to the campground. Personal washing is also not permitted in these areas.

**Rubbish** - Please dispose of your rubbish responsibly. Recycling bins are located in the woodland parking area in Inverdrue. All other rubbish must be taken to Granish rubbish dump at the north end of Aviemore.

**Fires and Firewood** - Fires are only permitted in the fire pit. If the High Fire Risks signs are up fires are strongly prohibited. If your group requires firewood please contact the Ranger Service who will tell you where fire wood is allowed to be gathered. Please do NOT gather firewood from the Loch an Eilein area as this is a deadwood preservation area.

**Volunteering Task** - All groups that use Loch an Eilein campground are asked to complete a volunteering project during their stay in a way to contribute to the up keep of

Rothiemurchus and get a greater understanding of the forest, biodiversity etc. The Ranger Service will contact you before or during your stay to organise this.

**Loch & Castle** - boating is permitted on Loch an Eilein under the Scottish Outdoor Access Code, if you do boat on the loch please adhere to the guidance and responsibilities set out in the code – contact a Ranger for information before going out onto the water.

Access on to the castle and island is strongly prohibited due to dangerous crumbling condition of the castle and high likelihood of rock fall.

**Departure** - The site must be left clean and tidy. All rubbish must be removed and taken to Granish dump in Aviemore. Please ensure the fire is completely extinguished and any un-burnt timber is stacked neatly.

**Failure to follow these terms and conditions will result in your group being asked to leave the campground and not being welcomed again.**
