

Camping on Comer Estate

Comer estate is a strong supporter of the DofE in Scotland and groups often camp in the Comer area.

To protect the nesting and lek grounds of the endangered Blackcock (Black Grouse) they ask that groups camp in two identified suitable campsites, to avoid disturbing the important habitat.

The estate are willing to discuss giving permission for vehicle access to visit groups, although no permission will be given for overnight stays. Groups wishing to access the estate using vehicles must also gain permission from the Forestry Commission who own the track to the approach road.

The estate are also keen to remind groups that the behaviour of the young people must comply with the Scottish Outdoor Access code, and especially that they should not make excessive noise.

Both campsites on the map below have been marked with a post with a white painted top and 'DofE'.
