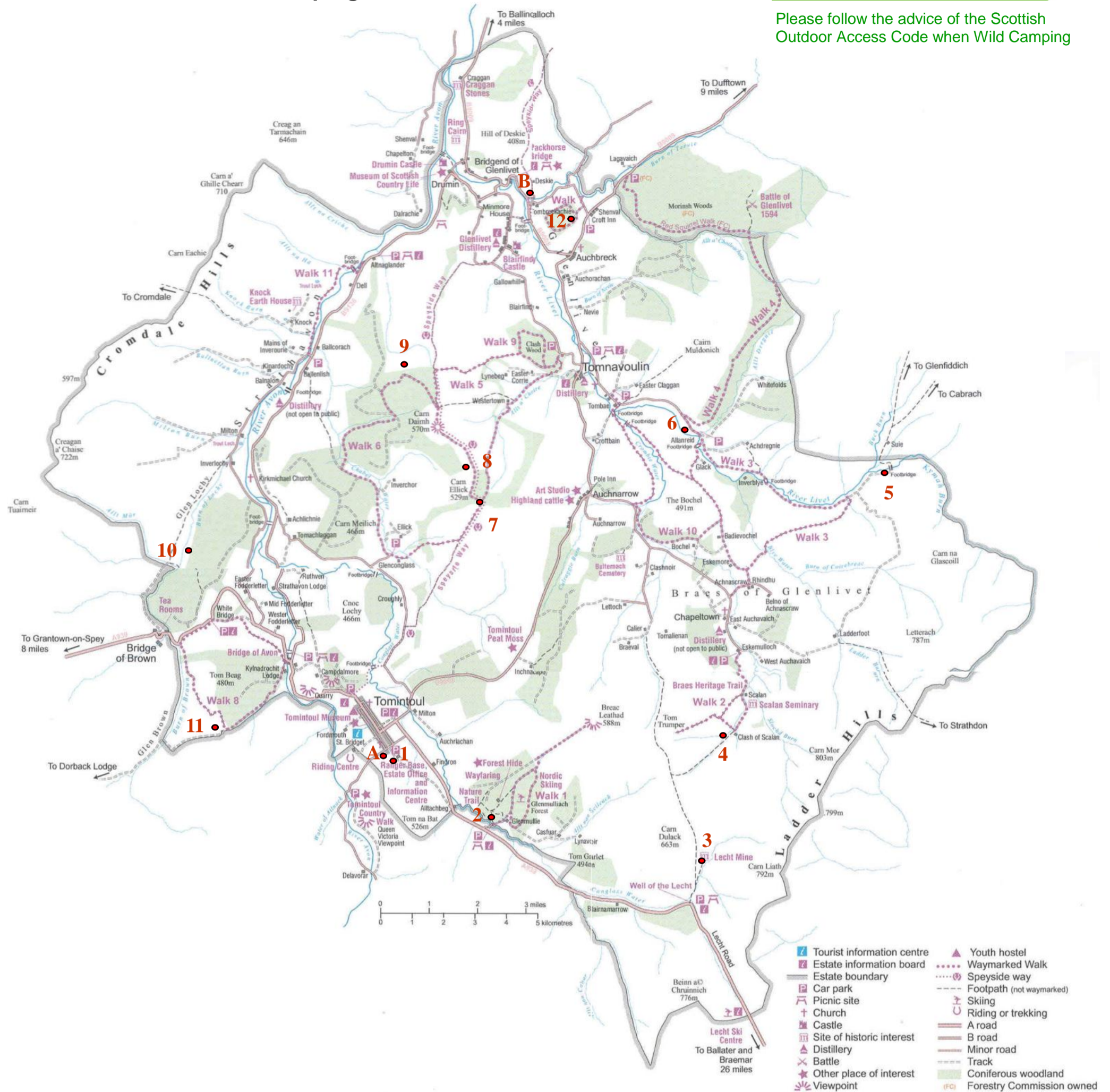

1	NJ 173 182	Glenlivet Estate Office	In woodland area adjacent to the Tomintoul Adventure Playground next to the Glenlivet Estate Office (Water available from tap outside Estate Office garage)	Toilets available at Estate office (when open—generally 9 am-5 pm weekdays) or in village
2	NJ 194 169	Glenmulliach picnic site	Picnic site next to car park	
3	NJ 238 159	Lecht mine	Flat patches for up to 4 tents upstream of old mine building	
4	NJ 243 186	Clash of Scalan	Flat area next to ruined buildings	
5	NJ 275 242	Suie bothy	Flat areas beside footbridge	
6	NJ 234 250	Allanried	200m NW of Allanried car park a small track on left beside burn. Follow for another 200m to large field beside River Livet	
7	NJ 190 234	Cairn Ellick	Small area in trees as Speyside Way leaves Cairn Ellick forest on S side (No water)	
8	NJ 189 241	Cairn Ellick	As Speyside Way leaves Cairn Ellick forest N side. Flat area beside track. (No water)	
9	NJ 180 262	Carn Liath	Beside trees. Rough heather with only a few flat areas. Can be wet	
10	NJ 128223	Glen Lochy	Beside Lochy Burn. Close to Ford where forest track crosses burn	
11	NJ 135 187	Stronachavie	Beside ruin next to track - west of forest gate	
12	NJ 210 292	Tom Dubh	Alongside forest track (no water)	
A	NJ 170 182	Tomintoul Highland Games Field	Suitable for larger groups. Large flat field on edge of Tomintoul.	Permission required from Highland Games committee
B	NJ 200 298	Glenlivet Hall	Suitable for larger groups. Serviced campsite field behind Glenlivet Village Hall	Permission required from Campsite
