# Volunteer role description

## Role: Central England DofE Ambassador

This role is an exciting opportunity for you to take a leading role in promoting, guiding and mentoring DofE participants in your centre.

You will be working alongside the DofE Manager in your centre to support participants to achieve their Awards.

There are a whole range of activities that you could get involved in such as:

- Helping to run a presentation evening.
- Running a promotional event to Year 8 students.
- Supporting participants to choose activities.
- Helping participants upload evidence to eDofE.
- Helping with the Expedition section.

And the added bonus – it can count as your Volunteering section activity. It's what you make it.

During your period as an Ambassador you will:

- Learn mentoring skills.
- Practice your presentation skills.
- Develop your leadership skills.
- Develop your own CV.

To support you in this role we will offer an online training session which will be packed full of exciting activities which will support you in your role as an Ambassador.

### You will learn about

- DofE programmes.
- eDofE.
- How to maximise the resources available to you.
- How to mentor participants.

You will leave the day with an action plan of the things that you want to do in your centre and some ideas about how to put these into practice.

To be a DofE Ambassador you must be currently enrolled for your DofE programme, or have completed a DofE level or a Certificate of Achievement.
