



Dear Participant,

Congratulations on taking part in the DofE – an adventure to change your life!

We do however note that you have not logged in to your eDofE account. In order to record and submit your activities, you will need to do so. Your Leader will then be able to check the activities you have chosen meet the section criteria. Activities must be approved by your Leader before you start them.

Visit www.edofe.org or download the eDofE app on your mobile's App Store and enter your username. If you have forgotten your username, please ask your Leader.

If you have never logged in, your password for the first time will take the form of your date of birth as a series of numbers with no forward slash markers; e.g. 01012017. You will then receive a message from the Duke of Edinburgh, followed by a page to fill in your details and a new password. You can then start completing your sections!

If this does not work, you can reset your password. When your Leader set up your account they should have added your email address to it. If you click the 'forgot your password?' link below, it will email you a link to login. You must click the link within **fifteen minutes** so please have your emails open ready to do this.
