How do I get involved?

In return for a donation to DofE Wales, CJCH Solicitors will draw up a free basic will, basic mirror will or help with any codicils.

There is also an opportunity to update your existing will. As you know life often changes and solicitors advise that you should review your will every five years and after any major changes in your life, e.g.:

- getting separated or divorced
- getting married (this cancels any will you made before)
- having a child
- moving house
- if the executor named in your will dies.

You may be aware that the average cost of making a will with a solicitor is (approximately £150 +VAT for a basic single Will, £250 +VAT for a pair of basic mirror wills. The average cost of a codicil is £80 +VAT).

CJCH Solicitors are donating their expertise and time for free, but would suggest a minimum donation to the DofE of:

- £100 for a basic single will or codicil
- £160 for a pair of basic mirror wills
