## Introduction to the Expedition Section and Roles – pre-course learning outcomes

### Course aim

The online Introduction to the Expedition Section and Roles (IttESR) module will introduce adults to the DofE's Expedition section and prepare them to attend a DofE Expedition Assessor and Supervisor Training Course (EASTC) or DofE Expedition Skills (DES) course.

Completing the IttESR is a pre-requisite for attending the EASTC and DES course.

To list the five stages of the Expedition process.	- Understand how expeditions should be prepared for, run and assessed.
To explain how Licensed Organisations and Approved Activity Providers contribute to the delivery of Expeditions.	- Explain the role of Licensed Organisations and Approved Activity Providers in running expeditions.
To explain the different adult roles involved in the delivery of Expeditions.	- Understand the ways in which adults are involved in Expedition delivery.
To make use of Expedition resources, as suitable to support your role.	- Locate the Expedition resources available to provide them with suitable further support.
To explain the options for putting the e-learning into practice.	- Appreciate the future training and DofE delivery options available to them.
