The Modular Training Framework

In order to support the adults who perform a variety of DofE delivery roles, the DofE has developed a comprehensive training programme. The Modular Training Framework (MTF) is a combination of e-learning modules, training courses and practical assessments.

e-induction

A free online learning programme, which gives a basic introduction to the DofE. Completing the e-induction is a pre-requisite for attending any classroom-based MTF course.

Introduction to the DofE (IttDofE)

The IttDofE course acts as a general introduction to the DofE and to DofE delivery roles. It outlines the relevant information to be a DofE Leader and run DofE programmes within a centre. An IttDofE Short course is also available.

Award Verifier (AV)

The AV course equips Award Verifiers with the necessary DofE programme and practical knowledge to undertake the Award Verifier role.

- **e-learning module:** Introduction to the Award Verifier e-learning.

Expedition training:

DofE Expedition Skills (DES)

The DES is a basic expedition skills course, intended to give expedition leaders and expedition support staff the theoretical and practical skills needed to support DofE expeditions (N.B. expeditions on foot, in normal, rural and open countryside – e.g. normal Bronze terrain).

- **e-learning module:** Introduction to the Expedition Section and Roles e-learning.

Expedition Assessor and Supervisor Training Course (EASTC)

The EASTC provides Expedition Supervisors and Assessors with an understanding of their role. It outlines the responsibilities of the Expedition Supervisor as the person responsible for the health and safety of an expedition team; and the Expedition Assessor as the person who confirms if a qualifying expedition meets the DofE's required 20 conditions.

The EASTC also outlines how these two roles work as a combined Supervisor/ Assessor role for Bronze expeditions and the Expedition Assessor Accreditation Scheme.

- **e-learning module:** Introduction to the Expedition Section and Roles e-learning.

Leadership training:

Managing a DofE Group

This course allows you to develop the skills that are essential in managing a DofE group.

Teamwork/Leadership Skills

Designed to link in with your DofE work, this module will provide you with the leadership and teamwork skills you need when working with DofE groups.

- **e-learning module:** DofE Leadership Workbook.

Practical DofE Leadership

Puts the theory from the Managing a DofE Group and Teamwork/Leadership Skills module into practice.

DofE Leadership programme

Completing all three elements of the Leadership programme allows you to gain the Certificate in Practical DofE Leadership.

Training the Trainers:

Train the Trainer

This course provides potential and existing trainers with the opportunity to explore training delivery methods, style and content and to facilitate high quality training provision.

Course Orientations are a 'train the trainer' module for each MTF course. They must be completed as part of the application process to be approved to deliver MTF courses.
