

Practical DofE Leadership

The Practical DofE Leadership programme has been developed to provide DofE Leaders with a foundation level of how to put into practice the skills needed to work in a DofE group.

This course is for those people who may be already doing this role who have received no formal training, those with a general interest in the subject or those who just wish to gain more skills and knowledge in a practical environment.

What will you need to do?

- Act as a Leader / helper at regular DofE group meetings
- Demonstrate leadership skills for a particular activity
- Plan, organise, initiate and develop an activity
- Identify the hazards associated with an activity
- Identify different methods of working with young people in a practical situation.
