AAP logo: The DofE AAP logo is a quality kite mark to endorse your DofE activities and publicise your DofE partnership to over 350,000 participants, Leaders and volunteers.



Website: Your own web page, linked via a listing on the DofE website to promote your organisation.

Support: Tailored to create and develop quality DofE programmes and branded promotional materials.

Contact: Direct support and a close working relationship with the AAP Team in Head Office as well as your local DofE Regional/Country Office.

Marketing opportunities: As well as free listings and webpages there are significant discounts for AAP advertising within the DofE commercial marketing campaigns.

Pre-approved activities: Your approved programmes will be accepted by Licensed Organisations for fulfilling DofE requirements.

Training: You will have access to induction training courses, virtual drop-in sessions and networking events.
